Visa information	The students must go to the Chilean embassy or consulate in their home country and apply for a student visa. They must submit a "Letter of Acceptance" issued by Universidad Finis Terrae that is sent to their Exchange Coordinator. Once in Chile the students have 30 days to present themselves at the "Policía de Investigaciones" to register and to obtain their temporary ID card at the "Registro Civil".
